## **Request for Voluntary Suspension**

International Graphite Ltd (ASX IG6) (the **Company**) requests a suspension of the Company's ordinary shares quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (**ASX**) in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2. with effect from the commencement of trading on Friday 25 July 2025.

In addition to an agreement to develop a new graphite processing facility in Europe, as referred to in the Company's letter dated 23 July 2025, the Company's major shareholder Comet Resources is in the process of completing a sale of securities it owns in International Graphite which is expected to be completed today (Stated Activities).

Voluntary suspension is requested to complete the Stated Activities.

The Company requests that the voluntary suspension remains in place until the earlier of commencement of normal trading on Monday 28 July 2025, or when an announcement regarding the Stated Activities is released to the market.

The Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted or of any further information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.

The Company notes the reference in the trading halt request dated 23 July to a 'grant' was an administrative error and that this reference should have been to an agreement to develop a new graphite processing facility in Europe.
