## ENVIRONMENTAL PROGRESS

**Titanium Sands Limited ("TSL" or "the Company")** is pleased to confirm further progress on the environmental studies for the Mannar Heavy Mineral Project (the Project) in Sri Lanka<sup>1</sup>.

The Project's environmental consultants in Sri Lanka are progressing field investigations, technical assessments and data collection at the Mannar Project Site. This has included the ecological field assessment, focusing on flora and an initial field visit by the Water Resources Board and Department of Agriculture.

A revised work schedule is expected to be submitted to the Company on completion of the remaining field visits, outlining the balance of work and timing of the completion of the required Environmental Impact Assessment.

**Titanium Sands Managing Director Dr James Searle** said "the Environmental Impact Assessment process is progressing in conjunction with many other aspects of creating this world class mining project. The team in Sri Lanka has done a great job to date and they all remain focused on building one of Sri Lanka's most significant HMS projects".
